A sign-up sheet to do the front table or outside sign is on the bulletin board. Check it out and see if there is a month you might like to help.

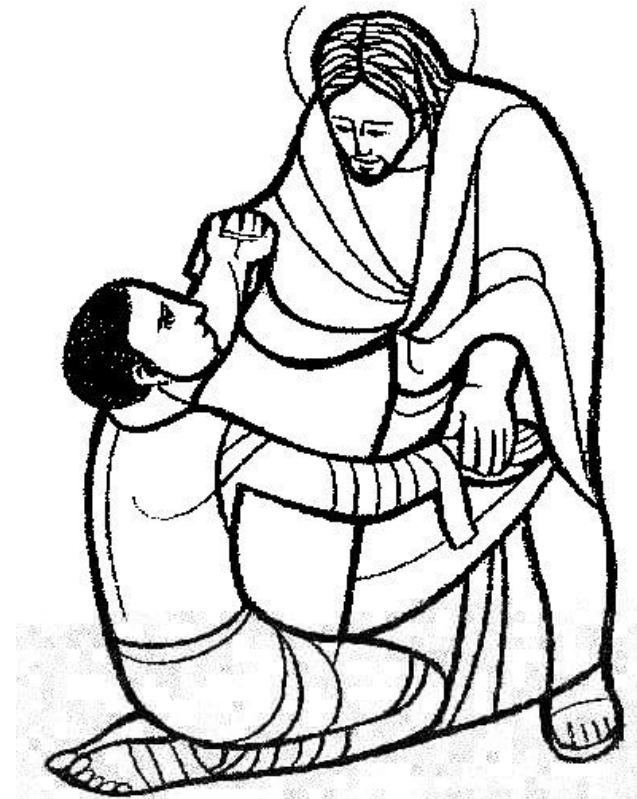
