Mission Offering for March is Lahash Rice and Beans. Lahash partners with local ministries across East Africa and the Rice and Beans project provides meals to hundreds of the most vulnerable children.

We will be having an Easter Sunrise Service at Hunsberger Farm on Mar 31 at 6:45 (the sun will rise at 7:00). This will be followed by a breakfast. If you would like to contribute to the breakfast, let Jeanette Hunsberger know or be watching for a sign-up sheet. We will have our regular Sunday morning Easter Worship at the church at 10:30.

MCC's work in Palestine and Israel: MCC is providing emergency relief with existing partners in Gaza, distributing locally purchased food packages, hygiene items and bedding as well as cash transfers to families in need. We are also working to help children cope with the trauma. In the West Bank, partners are providing food assistance and agricultural supplies and trainings for people who have been affected by the violence there. And in Southern Lebanon, MCC is providing emergency food for displaced people. MCC will continue to work with partners in both Palestine and Israel toward a just peace for all.
