While she did not enjoy online classes, she will not be permitted home until finals are over in November. Her mental health has taken quite a hit and we have never been apart for more than a week. So, we appreciate deeply your prayers, your concerns, your love and support. I am humbly aware that everyone's lives are impacted during this time and our family remains committed to serving however we can best be of service in our community. God's peace to each and every one of you. May your generosity be returned to you ten thousand fold. May you and your loved ones be blessed beyond measure.
