Welcome our guest speaker today, Nan McNinney who is the Local Food Systems Coordinator for Cambria County at the Center for Population Health. A big part of that job is working with organizations that support those with food insecurity by partnering with the Greater Pittsburgh Food Bank and the United Way of Laurel Highlands to offer SNAP benefits and produce vouchers. She works with the Backpack Project and local colleges to provide meals for low income and food insecure students. The Veterans Administration and Veteran's Leadership project are also partners serving low-income families. Seniors round out the population with help for produce and pantry staples. She is also working with the town of Nanty Glo on a large community garden project and hopes to work with farmers to add additional farmer's markets next year. Nutrition education is included in every neighborhood conversation!
