Elisabeth Elliot was a young missionary in Ecuador when members of a violent Amazonian tribe savagely speared her husband Jim and his four colleagues. This book is about her early years.

### **Choosing to See** by Mary Beth Chapman with Ellen Vaughn

This is the life story of Mary Beth Chapman, wife of recording artist Steven Curtis Chapman.
