**Changes to the constitution** have been brought forward by the Lay Leaders and Council. The proposed amendments were presented on Sunday January 17<sup>th</sup>. If you were not here, there should be a copy in your mailbox. Changes have been made to these three areas:

1. Membership Section: This update intends to more accurately reflect what membership looks like at Stahl currently, and paints a meaningful relationship between the members of the body.
2. Pastor Section: We have removed the parts of this section that conflicted or overlapped with the Pastor's covenant. The Lay Leaders also wish to affirm the Constitution's current definition of the Pastor's term as indefinite. This conflicts with the covenant and practice. There still will be a congregational affirmation of the Pastor's covenant and terms of employment, and a review/survey to evaluate the relationship between the pastor and the church.
3. Trustee Section: We are moving back to having three trustees who will each serve a term of three years. The Assistant Trustee position did not work as intended.
